The fueling station includes 30 time-fill posts for school buses and two fast-fill dispensers for refuse haulers, city vehicles and other customers.

The Visalia CNG fueling station will accept Visa and MasterCard and be weights and measures approved. Similar to its other facilities, this newest Pinnacle station will use the patented Hydraulic Intensifier Compressor (HIC) system and deliver CNG fuel at a rate exceeding normal gasoline fueling rates at approximately seven gasoline gallons equivalent (gge) per minute.
