The new CNG fueling facility will be a two compressor skid system, with each skid capable of delivering 700 scfm. The system has 100% back up capability. The Yolo County Transit fueling station will also accept Visa and MasterCard and be weights and measures approved. Similar to its other facilities, this newest Pinnacle station will use the patented Hydraulic Intensifier Compressor (HIC) system. This means that Yolo County Transit and public CNG users will not have to experience the frustrations of slower fueling rates, characteristic of a cascade system.
